Academic Curriculum (June 2025)

Paolo Giardullo, Ph.D. in Sociology of Cultural Phenomena and Normative Processes (2016 – University of Urbino, Carlo Bo), is a Tenure-Track Researcher (RTT) in Environmental and Territorial Sociology at the University of Padova, Department of Philosophy, Sociology, Education and Applied Psychology (FISPPA – Sociology Section). For the past five years, he has taught Environmental and Territorial Sociology (9 ECTS, module leader) on the Bachelor's Degree in Sociological Sciences, and Methodology and Techniques of Social Research (3 ECTS) at the same university.

In 2020, he was awarded the National Scientific Qualification (ASN) for the role of Associate Professor in the disciplinary sector 14/C1 – General Sociology (valid from 08/07/2020 to 08/07/2029). In February 2023, he obtained a second ASN as Associate Professor in the disciplinary sector 14/D1 – Sociology of Economic, Labour, Environmental and Territorial Processes (valid from 01/02/2023 to 01/02/2034).

He is a member of the research unit Pa.S.T.I.S. (Padova Science, Technology and Innovation Studies), where he contributes to national and international scholarly initiatives in the field of Science and Technology Studies (STS), particularly focusing on science and technology communication (PCST) and the use of digital media in analysing environmental issues.

In terms of research, Paolo Giardullo has long been engaged in the development and application of mixed-method research approaches, combining various investigative techniques, including media analysis and digital methods. He is also pursuing a line of inquiry into the role of technologies in civic science processes (citizen science). This is informed by his two-year postdoctoral research experience within the NEWSERA project, funded under the Horizon 2020 framework, which he analyses through an STS lens, with a particular focus on data, platforms, and the algorithms shaping their function and user engagement.

He has participated in research funded through competitive national (PRIN) and international (FP7 and Horizon 2020) programmes, addressing themes such as Responsible Research and Innovation, air quality policies, and rejected forms of knowledge. Alongside these, he has explored the epistemological and methodological dimensions of digital sociology in a range of applied contexts, including consumer practices, and representations of the environment and nature.

In recent years, he has published extensively in both Italian and international journals, including *Science as Culture*, *Quality and Quantity*, *PLOS One*, *Public Understanding of Science*, *Food, Culture and Society*, *Environmental Science and Policy*, and *SocioLogica*. His publications include a monograph (*Non è aria. Cittadini e politiche contro l'inquinamento atmosferico – Il Mulino*), book chapters for Italian publishers (*Il Mulino*, *Guerini e Associati*) and international ones (including *Routledge*, *Cambridge Scholars Press*, and *Peter Lang*). Together with Francesco Miele, he co-edited a volume on algorithms and care processes for the *Science & Technology Studies* series published by *Palgrave Macmillan*, entitled *Reframing Algorithms*.

He has been a regular participant in national and international academic conferences, both as a presenter and as a member of scientific and organising committees. Notable conferences include those of: AIS – Sociology of Territory Section (Milan 2023); AIS – Methodology Section (Milan 2017); the Italian Environmental Sociology Network (Salerno 2019; Ferrara 2021; Syracuse 2023); ESA (Turin 2013; Barcelona 2021); EASST (2022; 2024); and STS Italia (2012, 2014, 2016, 2018, 2021, 2023).

Since 2019, he has been a member of the editorial board of *Tecnoscienza – Italian Journal of Science & Technology Studies* (ranked A for Area 14/C1; indexed in Scopus and Web of Science), where he has also served as editorial secretary. He is a member of national and international scholarly associations, including the European Association for the Study of Science and Technology (EASST) and the European Sociological Association (ESA). From 2022 to 2024, he served as Secretary of STS Italia – the Italian Society for Social Studies of Science and Technology, and has been elected Vice-President for the term 2025–2027.
