### Research activity

The purpose of the scientific activity of P. Milani is to carry out research relevant to social needs, which combines the heuristic dimension of research with the practical-transformative one. She managed a total research budget of over 5.000.00 Euros over the last 10 years.

2011 : she founded LabRIEF (<https://www.labrief-unipd.it>), a Research and Intervention Laboratory in Family Education. Three are the main research lines of LabRief:

1. intervention and research towards children and vulnerable families in the perspective of resilience;
2. study and shared research on parent-teacher relationship practices and co-education;
3. parenting support.

The most significant project managed by LabRIEF is P.I.P.P.I. (Intervention Program To Prevent Institutionalization), conceived by P. Milani, promoted and financed by the Ministry of Labor and Social Policies for the years 2011-2012 (first experimentation); 2013-2014 (consolidation and expansion); 2014-2019 (extension to 20 Italian Regions) aimed at implementing a national research-action-training program to reduce the risk of inappropriate removal of the child from the birth family and to guarantee to each child an intervention project based on uniform and relevant assessments.

Today P.I.P.P.I. it is the largest project in the history of Italian social policies, in terms of numbers of participants (6000 between policy-makers, managers, social workers, educators, psychologists, psychiatrists, etc.), of the extent of funding (plus 25,000,000 total Euros of public investment), of activities to be managed (the activities concern the areas of training, intervention and research), of extension over time (active since 2011 and continuously expanding).

Since August 2018, the Ministry of Welfare has requested a LabRIEF a new commitment concerning the activation of the new *Inclusion Income (ReI)* policy, now defined as the *Citizenship Income* by the National Law 4/2019, as documented by the Agreement signed on 02.08.2018 between the Ministry of Labor and Welfare and the FiSPPA Department, which provides for funding to the FiSPPA of € 1.245,000 for the period 2018-2021. The new law on the national measure to fight poverty in fact provides that every family can access a multi-dimensional assessment of need and indicates the methodology of P.I.P.P.I. as a basis for building this assessment.

Prof. Carl Lacharité invited P. Milani to join the Groupe de Recherche et d'Intervention auprès des enfants vulnérables et négligés (GRIN), a research team accredited and funded by the Fonds de Recherche du Québec 2017-2021.

From 2014 is scientific advisor of the TIPÍ Project (“Ticino Early Childhood, Promotion of a shared culture of childhood”) with SUPSI, within which Paola Milani has contributed to the development of TIPÍ resilience, to implement an adaptation of the Italian P.I.P.P.I. Program

From August 2016 to February 2017 she was appointed expert member of the Comité international de consensus, chaired by Laurence Rossignol, Ministre des familles, de l'enfance et des droits des femmes, to realize the “Mission ministérielle sur les besoins fondamentaux des enfants en protection de l'enfance”.

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
