



Cosimo Monteleone is Associate Professor in Representation of Architecture and Descriptive Geometry at the University of Padua (IT). He teaches at the bachelor, master and PhD levels.

He is currently working on descriptive geometry, stereotomy, geometrical analysis and virtual reconstruction of architecture and infrastructure, digital survey (lidar and photogrammetry), 3D modeling (CAD, BIM), virtual reality and augmented reality, 3D prototyping, file to factory processes, and parametric surfaces for design.

He is a member of the international research projects *Visualizing Cities*¹ and *Digital Bomarzo*:²

- *Visualizing Cities* explores digital and visual representation of landscapes, structures, environments, history, culture, architecture, events, and populations, using new technologies of surveying, mapping, imaging, 3D modeling, virtual and augmented reality.
- *Digital Bomarzo* is a 3D digital reconstruction of the original landscape, architectural objects and sculptures of *Parco dei Mostri* in Bomarzo, using laser scanners, photogrammetry and a non-destructive underground survey to investigate and reconstruct the original water system.
