My research interests revolve around the concept of landscape, explored in different directions:

- I. the ways in which mobility practices (non-motorized, active, sustainable, but also other mobilities, such as tourism) contribute to the processes of co-construction of places and landscapes as well as to individual and collective citizenship (this topic was explored with the PhD thesis, through the case of the Walking Groups in Bergamo).
- II. the relationship between landscape and tourism, with particular attention to terraced landscapes (deepening, among others, the cases of Valtellina and the island of Lesbos, Greece) and the landscapes of "slow" tourism (with the ongoing research project);
- III. the landscape in educational contexts, as a tool for the construction of conscious citizenship, awareness, justice and landscape democracy.
